

Tide Pool Etiquette for Beach Field Trips

Follow these guidelines to keep yourself and the animals on our beaches safe.

- Walk carefully; there is life beneath your feet.
- Touch gently with one wet finger.
- Observe animals where they are and avoid picking them up.
- Only move rocks that are small enough to be moved with one hand. Carefully return rocks to exact position you found them in.
- Do not remove anything natural from the beach. Many of the beaches here are protected by law.
- Carry a small garbage bag to pick up trash.
